**Adult and Dislocated Program Performance**

- Served 1,361 Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs clients with career advising services, occupational skills training related to IT, Healthcare, Advanced Manufacturing, Business & Finance. 500 clients enrolled in Metrics on-line training program (English and Spanish).
- Met and/or exceeded all 15 State performance measures at 90% or higher.
- Hosted eight job fairs, with six in low resource census tracts and two in partnership with San José City College.
